**PURPOSE:** To announce a change in the Warranty Administration Manual Procedure 503-038.

**DISCUSSION:** This warranty applies to new QSB5.9, QSB6.7, QSC8.3, QL9, QSM11, SDI and TDI engines sold by Cummins MerCruiser Diesel LLC. Inc. (CMD) that are used in marine propulsion applications anywhere in the world where CMD approved service is available.

**Coverage**

The **warranty start date** is the date of delivery of the Engine to the first user, or the date the unit is first leased, rented or loaned, or when the Product has been operated for 50 hours, whichever occurs first.

### **Limitations**

- During the Base Engine Warranty, CMD will pay reasonable travel expenses to and from the vessel when it is necessary for CMD authorized repair technicians to make on-site warranty repairs.
- CMD is not responsible for failures of maintenance components supplied by Cummins beyond 90 days after the coverage duration start date. Maintenance components include, but are not limited to: belts; hoses; sea water pump impellers; zinc plugs; oil filters; fuel filters; air filters; water filters; and fuel/water separator filters.
- **CMD supplied alternators and starters** are covered for 2 years or 2,000 hours (2 years 1,000 hours for Governmental Service rating) whichever occurs first.
- **Failures resulting in excessive oil consumption** must have adequate documentation to show that oil consumption exceeds CMD published standards before they are considered.
- **Failures of belts and hoses** supplied by CMD are covered only during the first 90 days of the warranty period.
- **Towing/Repair Dock/Harbor** charges are not covered.
